1. Welcome from Mrs Roberts

2. Ideas for Monday's assembly – article 26

Ambassadors from Y5 and Y6 will show a video clip to remind the school about the rights of the child. They will then talk about the 'Why Work?' workshop they were involved in this week and how this links to article 26. They will then tell a story about someone who, like Alex from Wednesday's assembly, has been financially supported by the government to obtain a good standard of living. Ambassadors from Y3 and Y4 will introduce the egg competition.

3. Global/ Arts Week

Mrs Roberts asked the group to think about ideas for Global/Arts Week. This will involve planning and leading a session in their own/other classes on the similarities and differences between sports/life/etc. in richer and poorer countries – this will link to UNICEF Soccer Aid challenge and discussions about access to the UNCRC.

As suggested by the Student Council, we will be having a 'decorate the egg' competition this year. The theme will be the rights of the child. The group have agreed on the following rights: to education; to play; to develop and share talents; to good quality health care/standard of living; to be protected; to have a voice; to think and believe what they want (religions).
