Impact statement: What is positive about the behaviour in school/in classrooms?

*Can Y3 and Y4 girls use the KS1 toilets? The reason for this is that some children are not flushing the toilets and they smell. Mrs Roberts asked the members to talk to their class about this. Toilet monitors to remind children. We could make posters.

*Can we have art home learning? Some of the LCC independent learning projects are art related.

*Can we have a waterfall in the pond? This would cost a lot and may get damaged by the KS1 children playing football. It would be nice to look at and be calming though.
