



Once upon a time, there lived a prince. He wanted to marry a princess but she needed to be a true princess.



He travelled far and wide but he couldn't find a true princess.




The prince returned to the castle, feeling sad.





That night, a very wet princess knocked on the castle door. "I am a princess. Please can I come in to get dry?" she asked.




The queen answered the door. "We shall find out if she is a true princess," she thought.
