<p><b>Colour mixing</b></p> <p>Mix some primary coloured paints (red blue and yellow). Place each colour onto an old plate and encourage your child to place each of their hands in a different coloured paint, e.g. one in blue and one in green. Then tell your child to rub their hands together and watch the magic happen! <p><b>Smack It</b></p> <p>Prepare some sticky notes with various numbers (1-5 then 10) and place them in front of the children armed with fly swatters. Say a number. <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Read several books each day. Talk about the books that you read/share:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What does your child like about the story?</li> <li>• How are the stories similar? How are they different?</li> <li>• Which is their favourite page? Talk about the language of stories, for example.
