As Readers we will:

- * Listen to the stories of 'Percy the Park Keeper' by Nick Butterworth.
- * Read the poem; *What is pink?* By Christina Rossetti.
- * Continue to use our phonics to help us learn and read new words.

As Authors we will:

- * Write sentences to form a short narrative.
- * Write a short colour poem.
- * Use our phonics when spelling new / tricky words.



As Citizens we will:

- * Continue to develop our understanding of emotions through our PATHs learning.
- * Learn about how we can look after each other and the world.
- * Study Christianity and discuss the importance of belonging.



As Artists and Musicians we will:

- * Learn how to create 'Landscape Art'.
- * Look at different sculptures and create our own sculpture.
- * Take part in 'Songfest'.

In our MFL lessons we will:

- * Continue to learn 'French'.
- * Learn 'colours' in French.

As Mathematicians we will:

- * Find halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.
- * Describe turns and positions.
- * Consolidate our understanding of numbers within 100.
- * Recognise coins and notes.
- * Count with coins.
- * Begin to tell time-to the hour and half hour.
- * Continue to develop our mental maths skills-with our 99 Club and Fluent in Five Learning.



As Scientists we will:

- * Describe weather patterns and the features of weather that change across the different seasons.

As Athletes we will:

- * Take part in weekly lessons with Coach James.
- * Take part in Keep Fit Fun sessions with coach once a week.
- * Take part in a weekly KABS session.
- * Take part in Sports Day and try out different sports in PE Week-such as Golf and Orienteering.
