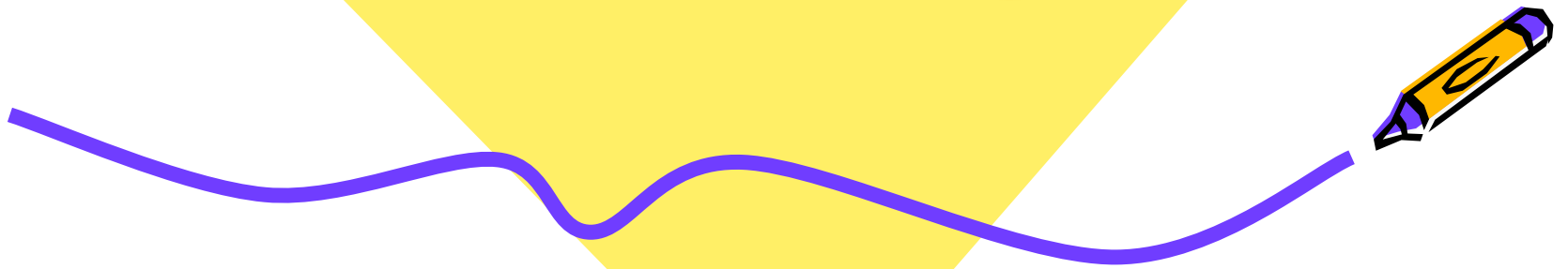

**A summary of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child**

<b>Article 1</b> Definition of child The Convention applies to all children below the age of 18 years.	<b>Article 10</b> Child's best interests The best interests of the child shall be a primary consideration in all actions concerning children.	<b>Article 19</b> Child's protection States shall take all appropriate measures to protect the child from all forms of neglect, abuse and exploitation.
<b>Article 2</b> Non-discrimination States shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national, ethnic or social origin, property, disability, birth or other status.	<b>Article 11</b> Child's contact with family States shall ensure that a child who is separated from his or her family remains in contact with his or her family, unless it is contrary to the child's best interests.	<b>Article 20</b> Child in need of special care States shall take special care of children who are in need of special care.
<b>Article 3</b> Best interests of the child In all actions concerning children, the best interests of the child shall be a primary consideration.	<b>Article 12</b> Child's views States shall ensure that the views of the child are given due weight in accordance with the child's age and maturity.	<b>Article 21</b> Child's right to a standard of living States shall take appropriate measures to ensure that the child has a standard of living adequate for the child's physical, mental, moral, and social development.
<b>Article 4</b> Implementation States shall take all appropriate measures to give effect to the rights recognized in the Convention.	<b>Article 13</b> Child's right to privacy States shall protect the child's privacy and shall ensure that the child's name and other identifying information is not disclosed to the public.	<b>Article 22</b> Child refugee States shall take special measures to protect the child who is a refugee or stateless person.
<b>Article 5</b> Parental guidance States shall ensure that parents or other persons who have the care of the child receive appropriate guidance and support in fulfilling their parental responsibilities.	<b>Article 14</b> Child's right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion States shall respect the child's right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion.	<b>Article 23</b> Child with disabilities States shall take special measures to ensure that the child with disabilities has full enjoyment of the rights recognized in the Convention.
<b>Article 6</b> Child's right to life States shall ensure that the child's right to life is protected.	<b>Article 15</b> Child's right to freedom of expression States shall respect the child's right to freedom of expression.	<b>Article 24</b> Child's right to the highest attainable standard of health States shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that the child has the highest attainable standard of health.
<b>Article 7</b> Child's right to know and be cared for by his or her parents States shall ensure that the child knows and is cared for by his or her parents as far as possible.	<b>Article 16</b> Child's right to freedom of assembly and association States shall respect the child's right to freedom of assembly and association.	<b>Article 25</b> Child's right to a fair trial States shall ensure that the child has a fair trial.
<b>Article 8</b> Child's right to maintain contact with his or her family States shall ensure that the child has the opportunity to maintain contact with his or her family.	<b>Article 17</b> Child's right to access to information States shall ensure that the child has access to information.	<b>Article 26</b> Child's right to social security States shall take appropriate measures to ensure that the child has access to social security.
<b>Article 9</b> Child's right to be separated from his or her parents States shall ensure that the child is not separated from his or her parents unless it is in the child's best interests.	<b>Article 18</b> Child's right to parental responsibility States shall ensure that the child has access to parental responsibility.	<b>Article 27</b> Child's right to an adequate standard of living States shall take appropriate measures to ensure that the child has an adequate standard of living.
<b>Article 10</b> Child's right to enter his or her own country States shall ensure that the child has the right to enter his or her own country.	<b>Article 19</b> Child's right to protection from violence States shall take all appropriate measures to protect the child from violence.	<b>Article 28</b> Child's right to education States shall ensure that the child has access to education.

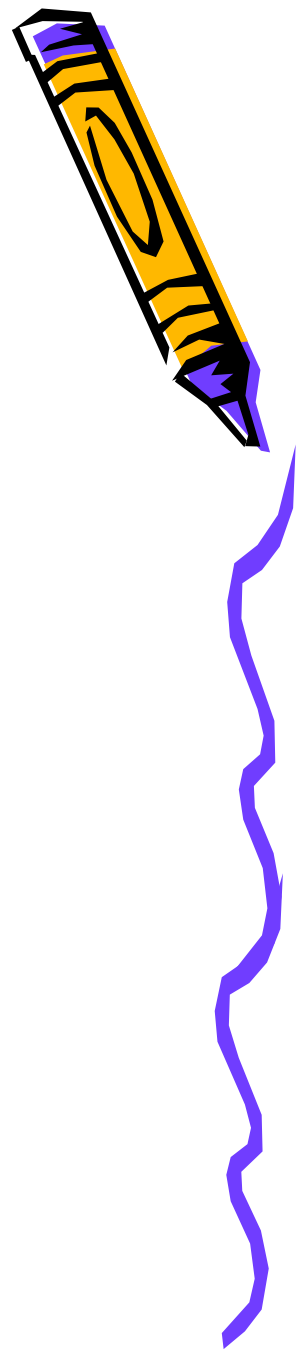

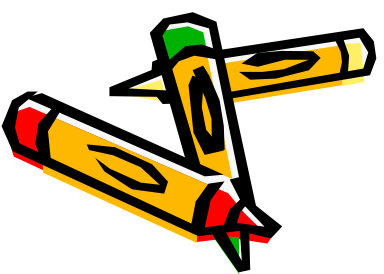
