

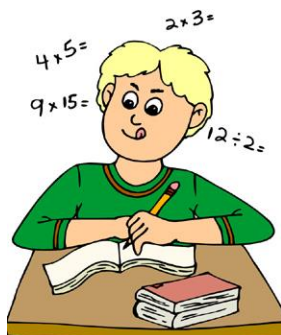
Multiplication and Division Facts –The 99 Club

The New National Curriculum requires children to recall all the multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 , by the end of Year 4.

Last year saw the launch of 99 Club across the whole school. This scheme is designed to improve children's knowledge of times tables.

From Year 2 the children are tested every week on specific multiplication facts. To help your child, it would be great if you could support them in learning these facts inside out and back to front. For example do they know that $3 \times 4 = 12$, $4 \times 3 = 12$, $12 \div 3 = 4$ and $12 \div 4 = 3$?

Once a child correctly answers all the questions within ten minutes they progress to the next level. As the children progress they will be working towards 144 Club Champion.
